



CITY OF OCEANSIDE BEACH AREA RESIDENT PERMIT PARKING PROGRAM RULES AND REGULATIONS

PLEASE READ THE FOLLOWING INSTRUCTIONS

The purpose of the program is to provide residents within the boundaries of the metered area and four-hour parking zones an on-street permit parking alternative. Resident and guest permits may be assigned to residents of eligible dwelling units who live in the program boundaries (see attached map) and can demonstrate adequate on-site, off-street parking is not available. The cost of each permit is \$10. Permits are non-refundable.

- **Resident Permit** – non-transferable decal/virtual permit will be assigned only to residents with an address on a street located within the program boundaries and can demonstrate adequate on-site, off-street parking for vehicles owned by the resident is not available. **One (1) permit per vehicle owned above and beyond available parking.** Decal will be affixed to the driver's side windshield lower left corner. The vehicle that has been assigned a resident permit shall display the vehicle's license plate at all times pursuant to California Vehicle Code.
- **Guest Permit** – transferable hanger/virtual permit assigned to eligible residence. **Only (2) guest permits can be purchased per residence.** Permit must be **hung from the rearview mirror, unobstructed with printed side facing outward for easy visibility.** Resident is responsible to assign the permit to the guest license plate when in use. The vehicle that has been assigned a guest permit shall display the vehicle's license plate at all times pursuant to California Vehicle Code.
- **Proof of residency and current government issued ID are required.** Proof of residency may be demonstrated by:
 1. Proof of current voter registration at an address within the program boundaries;
 2. Proof of current registration of the motor vehicle for which the permit is assigned showing the registered owner's address at the eligible dwelling;
 3. A currently valid lease or other rental agreement; or
 4. A currently valid utility bill showing service and mailing to the resident applying for the permit at the qualifying address.
- Permit will not be issued until the buyer has cleared all outstanding parking citations.
- Resident and guest permits are **valid for one (1) calendar year.** Resident must apply for a new permit upon expiration.
- If lost or stolen, replacement parking permits are \$25.00 each.
- Vehicles displaying permits shall be allowed to **park up to a seventy-two-hour (72) maximum** on streets within the program boundaries without being subject to parking control by meter or time limited zone.
- North Coast Village does not qualify.
- Permits are **not valid during street sweeping hours.** Vehicles must be moved during posted street sweeping times. Please locate the nearest sign posted on your side of the street for street sweeping days and times.
- **Permits are not valid in any city parking lot or at any metered space outside of the program area.**
- Vehicles are required to obey all other applicable parking laws and regulations. This program shall not relieve any property owner from any obligation imposed by any zoning ordinance or land use regulations to provide on-site, off-street parking spaces as a requirement of development.
- Any disregard for the ordinance or the misuse of the residential parking permit or guest permit will result in citations being issued. The owner of the vehicle will be held responsible for any citations issued. **Citations will not be dismissed.**

BEACH AREA RESIDENT PERMIT PROGRAM AREA

- Pacific Street north of Wisconsin Ave to Seagaze Dr and from Civic Center Dr to Breakwater
- Myers Street north of Wisconsin Ave to Seagaze Dr and from Civic Center Dr to Sportfisher
- Portions of the following streets west of the railroad tracks: Neptune Way (Eighth), Windward Way (Seventh), Surf rider Way (Sixth), Sportfisher Dr (Fifth), Civic Center (Fourth), Pier View Way (Third), Mission Ave, Seagaze Dr (First), Tyson St, Fir St, Pine St, Elm St, Ash St, Oak St, and Wisconsin Ave (north side only).

ADDITIONAL RESTRICTIONS (in addition to the Rules and Regulations on the front of this page)

- Permits CAN NOT be used at – N Side of 100 Seagaze Dr, S Side of 100 Civic Center Dr, 100 North to 300 N Pacific St, 100 N to 300 N Myers St, and Pier view Way
- Permits CAN NOT be used to park on The Strand - stopping, standing or parking is prohibited.
- Permits ARE NOT VALID at red curbs, alleys or to exempt street sweeping ordinance.
